The students are working on:

- *Reading sight words and short words and using them in full sentences when speaking and writing by tapping the sounds of the letters and putting them together
 - *Saying the name of each letter and the sound it makes
 - *Asking and answering questions about books using text vocabulary(when writing and speaking).
- Addition and Subtraction up to 20

Grades 4 and 5

Students are working on:

- *Asking and answering high level inference questions about books using text evidence and vocabulary (in writing and discussion)
- *Writing responses and discussing responses to questions using RAPPS and Say Mean Matter!
- *Math-Geometry

Grade 1 and 2

1st grade/ 2nd Grade:

The students are working on:

- *using the sounds we know to tap out letters for writing and reading
 - * Reading sight words, blends, digraphs and using them in full sentences when speaking about text
 - *Asking and answering questions about books using text vocabulary and evidence (in writing and discussion)
 - *using Mnemonic devices such as RAPPS and Say Mean Matter to write complete writing pieces!
- Addition/Subtraction (Grade 2 –Three digit numbers

Resources continued.....

Restate the question in a topic sentence or opinion sentence

Answer the question

Provide specific text evidence

Say- state the quote “...”

Mean- This means that...This tells me that..... (in your own words)

Matter- This is important because it tells me that.....

Sum it up (write a conclusion)

O state your **opinion** using words from the question)

R Give a **reason** from the text

E **Explain** the reason in your own words

O Repeat the **opinion** as a conclusion
