- label items around your home

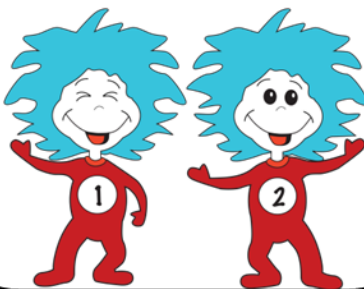
